RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF SAYREVILLE, COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING THE BOROUGH POLICY ON HEALTH BENEFIT WAIVERS

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Sayreville wish to amend the policy authorizing Borough Employees and Retirees, to opt out of the Borough's Health Insurance Plan and receive monetary benefits as follows:

- 1. Effective January 1, 2023, a Borough employee who is eligible for health insurance from the Borough through their spouse or domestic partner who is also a Borough employee or Borough retiree who receives Borough provided health insurance shall not be entitled to any monetary compensation for waiving health coverage.
- 2. Effective January 1, 2023, a Borough employee who is eligible for health insurance from the Borough through their parent(s) or guardian(s) (dependent coverage) shall not be entitled to any monetary compensation for waiving health coverage.
- 3. Effective January 1, 2023, a Borough employee who is eligible for compensation for waiving health coverage must demonstrate that they have alternative health coverage by submitting documentation verifying such alternative coverage by October 15 of the prior year and must sign the required "Employer Insurance Waiver" form on an annual basis. Eligible employees will be compensated in an amount equal to 25% of the saving to the Borough, after deducting any required employee contribution, not to exceed \$5,000.00 for a full year waiver of coverage. Waivers for less than a full year will entitle the employee to a pro-rated portion of the waiver and compensation.
- 4. Retirees shall not be entitled to payment for waiving health benefits. Employees eligible for a waiver payment who retire during the year will be entitled to a pro-rated payment for the portion of the year they waived coverage as an employee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Sayreville does hereby amend the Borough of Sayreville Employee and Retiree Insurance Waiver policy as set forth in the above resolution and shall be effective immediately.
