ORDINANCE #05-26
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, "ADMINISTRATION",
SUBSECTION 2-41, "HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION"
OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE
BOROUGH OF SAYREVILLE

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Sayreville, in the county of Middlesex, that the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Sayreville are hereby amended as follows:

2-41.2 Appointment of Commission. The local Commission shall consist of ~~eight (8)~~ **nine (9) residents of the Borough** who shall serve without compensation. The members of the Commission shall possess a diversity of qualities, religious beliefs and social experience. Each member shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the advice and consent of Council, for a term of three (3) years and until his successor is appointed and qualified.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Sayreville, in the County of Middlesex, that Chapter 2-41, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Sayreville, shall also be amended to reflect such change.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
